

## PROCEDURE TO INSTALL TI-SMART VIEW SOFTWARE

1. Go to the URL below:

<http://ctislab.fhda.edu/~barreto/TI-Smartview/>

Download the “setup.ini” file in the directory and then click on the folder for your operating system (OSX or WIN) and download the installer in that folder. Both files downloaded must be in the SAME folder on your computer.

2. **IMPORTANT:** Windows 8 added a “.txt” extension when I downloaded the “setup.ini” file. If this is the case remove the “.txt” from the extension and make sure that the setup file has the extension “.ini”. This also happened when I selected Save Page As on my Mac, so again you will need to remove the “.txt” extension and make sure the extension is “.ini”.
3. Run the TI-SmartView installer and install the software.
4. The installer should put a shortcut to the program on your Windows desktop. On my Mac I had to run the program by searching for it in my Applications folder. Launch the program and it should validate our license automatically with no further action on your part. If not, contact Luis Barreto (X7620) for help.
5. **NOTE:** Our license allows 5 concurrent users of the software. If you are unable to launch the software it “might” be due to the fact that 5 people are already using the software. Luis can check how many people are using the software if you think that this is why you cannot launch the software.

## ONE FINAL TIDBIT

This software is more advanced than previous versions of SmartView. In particular, you can now select a standard TI-84 Plus emulator OR an enhanced TI-84 Plus C emulator that has nicer resolution for graphs and also graphs functions in color. You can toggle between each emulator using the menu shown below.
